Getting exposed to too much mana on this scape gives us manarash but dying up there just makes us vulnerable. Except manarash **does** make you vulnerable to magic of that color. But the vulnerable didn't give us the other symptoms of rash. So what's different? People talk about people having their own personal scapes right? I think someone who knows magic said something about that. So what if being on the manascape means our manascapes were fucked with instead of our landscapes. That would make sense.

Okay okay what else. Aeliana said my teeth look filed, not natural. That means it's not some kind of mutation but it was done on purpose. So maybe the color woods? Why did Zet have to die? I could have talked to him about this. I wonder if the color woods people are still here I should check. It would make sense, I like fighting more now. That's not very lakeshore but it is pretty color woods. Which begs the question of how much experiences we don't remember effect us. Again that's a question for Zet.

What scape you're in affects what scape of yours gets fucked with by too much mana. So in the manascape our manascapes got screwed but when we're here on the landscape our bodies get fucked.
